

Hōm Hotel Santorini

SANTORINI, GREECE

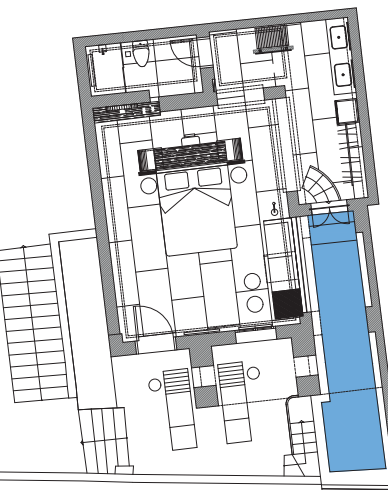
Located on a sloped site in Oia with views towards Thirasia and the Aegean Sea, the hotel is conceived as a composition of independent suites and shared spaces, including reception, restaurant, and pool. The project focused on reorganizing the existing structure both functionally and aesthetically, unifying the development into a coherent whole while respecting the local architectural language. The design aims to create an atmosphere reminiscent of a cluster of small houses rather than a conventional hotel. Through targeted interventions in each space, a sense of familiarity and privacy is achieved. The project incorporates an unfinished existing structure alongside a traditional building, forming the basis for the new development. Organized across four levels, the hotel comprises 13 suites along with reception, a bar-restaurant and a pool. Access is from the upper level at street level, with the program cascading down the slope: reception above, communal areas with pool and restaurant in the middle, and

suites distributed across the lower levels. Each suite features a private balcony and jacuzzi, oriented to capture views of the Aegean Sea and Thirasia while maintaining privacy. The architecture combines functional clarity with a restrained, context-sensitive design, resulting in a composition that integrates with both the topography and the local built environment.

GETTING AROUND. HŌM HOTEL SANTORINI IS SET ON THE ISLAND'S SCULPTED CALDERA, SURROUNDED BY VOLCANIC CLIFFS, WHITEWASHED VILLAGES, AND THE LUMINOUS AEGEAN LIGHT. THE LANDSCAPE IS DEFINED BY STEEP EDGES, SMALL COVES, AND VINEYARDS SHAPED BY THE ISLAND'S UNIQUE GEOLOGY. CLIFFSIDE PATHS LEAD TO HISTORIC SETTLEMENTS AND VIEWPOINTS, WHILE THE ARCHAEOLOGICAL SITE OF AKROTIRI OFFERS INSIGHT INTO A BRONZE AGE SETTLEMENT PRESERVED IN VOLCANIC ASH. THE HOTEL SERVES AS A SERENE VANTAGE POINT WHERE LANDSCAPE, CULTURE, AND CONTEMPORARY DESIGN COME TOGETHER IN A BALANCED AND IMMERSIVE SETTING.
